Class Kit Fee Collection and Reimbursement Agreement:

Sew Bestie is responsible for the collection of class kit fees on behalf of teachers facilitating sewing classes at Sewcation events. The reimbursement process is outlined as follows:

1. Collection of Class Kit Fees:

- Sew Bestie will facilitate the collection of Registrations and Class Kit fees directly from participants registered for each sewing class.
- Teachers are not permitted to collect fees directly from participants during the event, all payments shall be collected by Sew Bestie.

2. Reimbursement Timeline:

- Teachers will receive an advanced reimbursement of collected class kit fees 2 weeks after initial registration opening.
- Final Reimbursement to teachers will be processed within 3-4 weeks after the completion of the contracted Sewcation event.
- Teachers will be notified of the status of their reimbursement requests in a timely manner.
- All Teachers need to submit a W9 for payments for fee payments.

3. Communication:

• Teachers are encouraged to communicate any questions or concerns regarding reimbursement directly with the designated contact person at Sew Bestie.

4. Payment of Service

• A Letter of Agreement signed by Sew Bestie and you will outline individual arrangements, including teacher payments at each event for which you are scheduled.
